



Agreement for Supervised Therapeutic Visitation

Beliza Perdomo, LMFT has provided a copy of the [Standard 5.20 of the California Standards of Judicial Administration](#) and [Family Code section 3200.5](#).

Beliza Perdomo, LMFT has provided me with a signed Declaration of Supervised Visitation Provider (CA FL-324). Beliza Perdomo, LMFT has not filed this document with San Luis Obispo County Family Court, but if agreed to by both guardians, FL-324 may be filed. Beliza Perdomo, LMFT will not be responsible for any costs associated with the filing of document FL-324.

Beliza Perdomo, LMFT has informed me that no confidential privileges exists during supervised therapeutic visitation. If ordered by the court or requested by either party or the attorney for either party or the attorney for the child, a report about the supervised visit will be produced. These reports may include facts, observations, and direct statements or recommendations regarding future visitation. The original report must be sent to the court if so ordered, or to the requesting party or attorney, and copies should be sent to all parties, their attorneys, and the attorney for the child.

Beliza Perdomo, LMFT will be provided with: A) Copies of any protective order; B) Current court order; C) Any Judicial Council form related to supervised visitation orders; D) A report of any written records of allegations of domestic violence or abuse; and E) An account of the child's health needs if the child has a chronic health condition.

Safety procedures: Beliza Perdomo, LMFT will make every reasonable effort to assure the safety and welfare of the children and adult(s) during visitation. Should a crisis rise to a degree which intervention is indicated, Law Enforcement will be contacted.

If Beliza Perdomo, LMFT determines that the rules of the visit have been violated, the child has become acutely distressed, the safety of the child or the provider is at risk, or a parent or guardian is behaving in a manner counterproductive to reunification, the visit may be temporarily interrupted, rescheduled at a later date, or terminated.

Unless otherwise ordered by the court, supervised visitation will occur every other week (or per the therapists recommendation) and gradually transition to 1-3 times per week until parties are prepared to engage in unsupervised visitation. At the therapists discretion, supervised visitation may occur outside of the therapists office such as the park, restaurant, or agreed place of interest/comfort to both parties.
